Proper identification marks will greatly assist in returning the articles to their proper owner. Articles found unmarked will be turned over to the welfare agency at the end of the summer.

◆ Bathrobe and slippers	1. This list is ample for the camper's needs. PLEASE DO NOT SEND EXTRA AND UNNECESSARY ARTICLES.
◆ Baseball mitt	2. The use of baseball shoes with spikes is not permitted.
◆ Musical instruments	3. There are NO REQUIRED UNIFORMS.
◆ Favorite books and games	4. No hair dryers please.
◆ Waterbottle*	5. Because of our uneven terrain, open-toed or backless shoes are not permitted for daily wear.
◆ Ballpoint pen* or pencils*	6. Label <b>EVERYTHING!!!!!!!!!!</b>
