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2010 SENIOR TRIPS

Twice during the summer, the senior campers (14 & up) have the opportunity to participate in 4-day camping trips to Cape Cod, Massachusetts and Lake George, New York. These trips are at an additional cost, which covers the campground fees, admission fees, meals, and some spending money.

The first trip is held July 13th -16th in Cape Cod. We enjoy a day in Provincetown, MA, including lunch, a whale watching trip or deep-sea fishing trip, shopping, and people watching. Another day is spent at the National Seashore, where the waves are rolling and the sun is shining bright. In addition, we may see a movie, play miniature golf, spend some time at a local water park, and eat a Cape-style seafood dinner. The second trip is held August 10th -13th to Lake George. We spend a day white water rafting on the Hudson River Gorge, stopping for a quick lunch and swim along the way. Another day is spent exploring the town and enjoying the Great Adventure amusement park. There is plenty of sightseeing on the trip.

These trips are co-ed and are supervised by senior staff and administrators. Any additional spending money for souvenirs and incidentals is optional and must be provided by the parents directly to the camper. No additional monies may be withdrawn from their canteen accounts, but we will cash a check for your camper if it is received early enough for us to take it to the bank.

A fee of \$300 per trip, payable to Ebner Camps, Inc., is required. This payment must be received in the camp office no later than the Sunday before the trip is scheduled to leave. (July 11 and/or August 8) We will be glad to answer any questions about the trips on Opening Day or Visiting Day. Each trip has a maximum number of 25 campers from each camp – spaces are reserved on a first come, first served basis.
